BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A. Within the framework of the Agreement Framework/Protocol of academic and scientific collaboration of University **DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR MARATHWADA UNIVERSITY, AURANGABAD-INDIA** and the **KOYASAN UNIVERSITY, JAPAN** wish to lay down the foundations to implement this Specific Agreement for Students Exchange.

B. Both parties acknowledge the importance of developing intercultural relationships and the benefits that will result from the academic opportunities for the students.

In view of the above, the two parties agree to implement this specific agreement in accordance with the principles and guidelines set forth below.

CLAUSES

1. Students (Research) exchange at the Master and Doctoral level, in the fields of Buddhism, Sanskrit, Pali, or other related fields to be agreed upon.

1.1 The DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR MARATHWADA UNIVERSITY, AURANGABAD-India and the KOYASAN UNIVERSITY, JAPAN undertake to carry out the exchange of students from each university. The exchange of students under this agreement may have duration of one month to one / two academic semester (s) or as specific duration permitted by the Governments of both Countries.

1.2 During the time this agreement is in force, both institutions agree to review annually the number of students sent and received and will attempt to maintain a balanced number, without said number having to be the exact same during a specific year. Students participating in the exchange program for one / two semester (s) will be considered to have completed one academic year with respect to the exchange balance.

1.3 The home University will select and nominate students to participate in this exchange program. The host University will take the decision regarding the acceptance of the students selected by the home institution. A student may be rejected in the event of exceptional circumstances which must be documented.



1.4 Each application for admission must be presented in written form to the appropriate office of the host institution and the candidate must include the following information:

Area of interest

Academic level: Masters / Doctoral level.

Nationality with Photocopy of passport

Transcript

List of courses candidate would like to take at the host University (study commitment)

1.5 The host institution will issue to each student who has been accepted a letter indicating his/her acceptance to the exchange program and admission to the University.

1.6 Students participating in the exchange program will continue as candidates for the official Degree at their home University and will not be eligible to earn official Degrees at the host University. The course of study of each participating student must be approved by the home University.

1.7 Students selected for the exchange program will pay the registration and tuition expenses at their University. The host University will not charge any



additional fees for these concepts. The participating student will be responsible for paying any additional fees related to special courses, recreational services or laboratory use.


1.8 Exchange students will be obliged to find their own accommodations, for which purpose, the host University will provide assistance. Exchange students will be responsible for paying any additional exchange expenses, including personal expenses, travel costs, accommodation and food.

1.9 Participating students will be responsible for taking out medical insurance and paying any medical expenses incurred during their stay at the respective Universities. Students accepted at both the Universities must also take out an accident insurance policy, which they may formalize upon arrival.

1.10 Students selected for exchange must follow the immigration requirements of the country where the host University is located. The said students will have all the rights and responsibilities that the host University has established for its own students. They shall abide by the University rules and regulations and may be subject to sanctions in the event that they do not comply with this section, in which case the home University shall be duly informed.

2 Administration and validity period

2.1 The administration of this specific agreement is the responsibility of both the University offices at Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad-India and Koyasan University, Japan, respectively.



BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A Within the framework of the Agreement Framework/Protocol of academic and scientific collaboration. DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR MARATHWADA UNIVERSITY, AURANGABAD-INDIA, the KOYASAN UNIVERSITY, JAPAN and the University wish to lay down the foundations to implement this Specific Agreement for the Exchange of teaching and research staff.

B. Both parties acknowledge the importance of developing intercultural relationships and the benefits that will result from the academic opportunities for their staff.

In view of the above, the two parties agree to implement this specific agreement in accordance with the principles and guidelines set forth below.

CLAUSES

ONE.- Selection of candidates for the exchange program :

During the first semester of the academic year, any interested department of Pali, Buddhism, Sanskrit and other related fields to be agreed upon will propose one or more candidates, with a maximum of four, to participate as Professors or researchers during the following academic year at the host University, in the event that the said candidates exist and are willing to accept this mission. The candidates proposed by each institution must be accepted and receive the confirmation by the host institution. All of the appointments and leaves that must be requested by the members of the teaching and research staff must go through the regular processes in effect at the candidate's institution.

TWO.- Appointment period :

1.4 The appointment period, barring exceptional cases, will be minimum for a period of 01 Month and maximum up to 06 months or as specific duration permitted by the Governments of both Countries.

THREE.- Obligations and responsibilities :

The professional and teaching obligations of the academic and administrative staff (statutory) who are participating in the exchange program from the host University shall not exceed the weekly duties required by their colleagues at the host University. The level of responsibility assigned will be in keeping with the rank and background of the Professor participating in the exchange.



FOUR.- Financing :

This agreement, in and of itself, does not represent any financial commitment and neither one of the institutions is obliged to reserve specific funds for any need that may arise from the said agreement. Participants in the exchange programs may benefit from financial aid provided by department funds, whatever their origin, and from any other assistance of a general nature provided by each University or other institutions or private entities, such as travel grants.

The home University support will facilitate the travel of the Academic and Administrative Staff in the framework of bilateral agreements, for the purpose of compensating for travelling expenses of his own staff the host University may provide supplemental assistance for the food and lodging of the guest Professors.

Applications for the financial aid described in the previous paragraph must be presented at the Departments of the KOYASAN UNIVERSITY, JAPAN and The University, DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR MARATHWADA UNIVERSITY, AURANGABAD- 431004 ' INDIA

During their residence at the host institution, Professors and researchers participating in the exchange program will receive their full salaries from their home institution, in addition to the supplements and social benefits to which they are entitled. The guest Professor or researcher must provide evidence to the Foreign Relations Services that he or she has valid medical insurance that will be able to cover health costs during the exchange period as required by the immigration legislation in force.



FIVE.- Administration :

The administration of this specific agreement is the responsibility of the University of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad-431004, INDIA and of Koyasan University, Japan.





A student may be rejected in the event of exceptional circumstances which must be documented.




